The Study's Scholarship & Bursary Programme

Last year, The Study granted over \$450,000 in scholarships and bursaries to approximately 20% of its students. Our financial awards programme supports a key strategic priority for The Study; a diverse and promising student population who will thrive in our enriched curriculum.

The school offers merit-based scholarships and need-based bursaries aimed at making a Study education as accessible and affordable as possible.

Note: both programmes are considered grants applied to tuition fees, they are not loans.

Scholarships

The Study acknowledges student achievement and contributions to the school community in a variety of ways. Scholarships recognize outstanding academic results and promise and in many cases are renewable, provided the recipient's academic work and contribution to the school remains at a high standard. These financial awards are available at various grade levels to both new and returning students and are not based on financial need.

Bursaries

World-class academic institutions such as ours recognize that the most outstanding young minds and great spirits deserve the opportunity to excel, despite their families' financial circumstances. At The Study, we are proudly committed to removing barriers of accessibility. The decision to award a bursary is based on a family's demonstrated financial need, as determined by a third-party assessment.

Entrance Scholarships

These scholarships are up to \$5000 and awarded annually to incoming students (grades 7) on the basis of overall academic excellence as evidenced by the entrance exam scores and potential to contribute to school life. These scholarships are renewable for three years provided the student maintains high academic standing.

Margaret Gascoigne Scholarship

This prestigious scholarship of up to \$5,000 is awarded in the name of the school's founder and is awarded to top new incoming grade 7 students on the basis of their entrance exam scores and a personal interview. This scholarship is renewable for five years provided the student maintains high academic standing.

Grade 7 / The Study School Foundation Merit Entrance Scholarship

(Full scholarship & renewable for five years)

A full scholarship is awarded to the top new student entering Grade 7 and is based on current report card, a personal letter of intent, an application and results of the entrance exam. The value of the full scholarship will be applied against school fees each year until the student graduates, provided that she continues to achieve proficiency standing and actively participates in school life. This scholarship is awarded every three years.

All applicants for grade 7 for 2020-21 are eligible to apply for this scholarship.

Trillium Scholarship

All Study students entering grade 10 are eligible to apply for this \$1,000 scholarship, awarded for academic merit and based on an essay and a personal interview. The scholarship is renewable for a further year provided the student maintains high academic standing.

Board of Governors' Scholarship

Current Study students entering grade 7 are eligible to write a Board of Governors essay in either French or English. This \$1,000 scholarship is awarded to a student based on her essay as well as a personal interview. This scholarship is renewable for three years provided the student maintains high academic standing.

Marcelle Gaudion Scholarship

Awarded to a current student in Grade 4 or 5, based on academic merit, a French essay and a personal interview. This \$1,000 scholarship is renewable for five or six years.
