Dear Study Parents,

We learned earlier today that a family member of a Senior School student has tested positive for COVID-19. The student was last in school on Friday, September 10, and is currently awaiting COVID-19 testing results. Unless you have been contacted by the administration, your daughter should continue attending school.

Our Emergency Health Officer, Johanne Denis, has reached out to Santé Publique for further directives and we will follow their guidance. The school remains open and we continue to be vigilant in applying all necessary measures to prevent transmission.

Your ongoing cooperation continues to be important. Please remain attentive in the monitoring of your state of health and that of your daughter. We encourage you to consult the health authorities' online COVID-19 Symptom Self-Assessment Tool. Onset or aggravation of a cough	General symptoms (muscular pain, headache, intense fatigue or loss of appetite)
Fever (38 C or more)	Sore throat
Difficulty breathing	Diarrhea
Sudden loss of smell with or without loss of taste, without congestion	Vomiting or abdominal pain

We will continue to keep you informed on all matters related to COVID-19 positive cases confirmed within The Study. Rest assured that we are monitoring the situation closely and in collaboration with our local health authorities. Our number one priority is the health and safety of our students, staff and their families.
